

We are excited as the Lord allows us to minister in places like Ethiopia, Ghana, Myanmar, a predominantly Buddhist country, United Arab Emirates, the Caribbean countries of Bermuda and Trinidad Tobago, along with the most progressive countries such as America, Canada, Australia and other European countries. Never in our wildest imagination have it ever crossed our minds that God will "enlarge our borders" in this way.



We now have a total of 161 students enrolled in the Newman Bible Academy some coming from far flung countries like the Norfolk Island, Cayman Islands, Saudi Arabia, Cameroon, Mauritius aside from many from the U.S.A, Philippines and Tonga.

SHORT-TERM MEDICAL MISSION PROJECT IN PALAWAN, PHILIPPINES

Esmie regularly meets with 8 to 10 Filipino women for Bible study and discipleship in Olympia, WA. She has been praying for the opportunity to get these women involved in a ministry or evangelism and discipleship to reach many, many Filipinos in their communities. After much prayers, Esmie challenged the women to participate in a short-term medical-evangelistic mission trip to the Philippines in February, 2011. In the past week, the project started gaining momentum, and a team is starting to form. Two dentists have signed up to participate, along with 3 to 4 nurses, plus the 7 women with no medical training. They are now in the process of working with the medical ministry outreach of Campus Crusade for Christ in the Philippines called Agape Rural (Health) Program. The team will work with a doctor in the Philippines who oversees this ministry. AR(H)P is a community based development program that seeks to help uplift the health conditions of the needy and underserved areas by enabling medical volunteers to implement a holistic program which caters for both physical and spiritual healing.

Their strategies include:

1. Campus Crusade for Christ will provide training for the U.S. team upon arrival on how to evangelize and do follow-up on those who receive Christ. Medical personnel will be oriented on the needs and approach used in providing help in the rural areas.
2. Establish a partnership with a local church so that those who will accept Christ will be taken care of after the project and the U.S. team departs.
3. Run a free medical and dental clinic in some remote places in Palawan, Philippines for 5 to 6 days.
4. While people wait for their turn in the waiting area, the evangelists (the U.S. non-medical crew along with the church people and Campus Crusade staff from the Philippines) will share the Gospel.
5. Meet those who express interest and those who have accepted Christ for follow-up after clinic hours, or in the evenings.
6. Bring the people who have accepted Christ and those who participated in the follow-up Bible studies to church.

We covet your prayers. Pray

- For the U.S. team – that God will protect each of them from anything that might hinder them from making it or participating.
- That our Jehovah Rophe – the Healer will perform supernatural physical healing through the hands of our medical crew.
- For the town folks in Palawan, especially those who will turn up at the clinic – that there will be a great harvest and spiritual healing
- That God will provide the finances for the project including for the medical and dental supplies we will have to help provide.
- That the U.S. participants and the participating Palawan church folks will catch a vision, and will be emboldened to make evangelism and discipleship a way of life.
